Our May Board meeting was held via email and telephone, and the following officers were elected for 2020-2021:

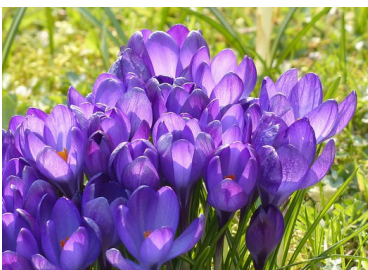
