The historic Blizzard of 1978, which began on Wednesday, January 25 and lasted through January 27, caused wintry chaos across the Midwest.

According to the National Weather Service, it is the worst blizzard on record for the Hoosier state.

In Grant County, many of us remember the sound of the wind, the whiteout conditions, and the accumulation of drifting snow.
